**Resolution 2009-16**

**Providing for a Reappointment to the Emergency Preparedness Committee**

WHEREAS, the City Council established the Emergency Preparedness Committee to provide community input and assistance in the City's planning and preparations for emergency operations; and

WHEREAS, as amended by Ordinance 2006-6, the committee is composed of appropriate senior City Staff selected by the City Manager, one member selected by the Public Safety Citizens Advisory Committee, one member selected by the Takoma Park Volunteer Fire Department, one member selected by Washington Adventist Hospital, one member selected by the Montgomery County Department of Homeland Security, and seven residents appointed by the Council; and

WHEREAS, there are two members whose terms expired on March 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, Anne Ludlow has applied for reappointment to the committee; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has found Ms. Ludlow to be a qualified candidate for reappointment.
