**CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND  
RESOLUTION 2010-16**

**ENDORISING SMALL COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM AWARDS**

WHEREAS, the City Council established the Small Community Grant Program to provide grants of \$2,500 or less to community groups wishing to conduct activities that further the Council's goals as set forth in the City's Strategic Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Council allocated \$20,000 in the FY 2010 budget for the Small Community Grant Program; and,

WHEREAS, in response to the City's call for applications, 10 submissions were received by the February 12, 2010 deadline; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Small Community Grant Program's procedures, the applications were reviewed by the Small Community Grant Review Committee and by a committee of City staff; and,

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the comments and recommendations of the Committee and staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND that the following grants are awarded pursuant to the terms of the Small Community Grant Program and subject to any contingencies noted below:

1. Art for the People – Westmoreland Wall Program (\$2000);
2. Crossroads Farmers Market – Rolling Terrace PTA and Crossroads Farmers Market Partnership Healthy Eating Initiative (\$2,500);
3. John Guernsey – “Love at Last Sight” a Musical (\$500)
4. New Hampshire Gardens Citizens Association – Revitalization of the Association (\$1,755)
5. Pyramid Atlantic, Inc. – Takoma Park/Silver Spring Experimental Film Festival (\$2,500)
6. Takoma Park Jazz Fest (\$2,400) – funding contingent upon a) submission of survey results noted in the application, and, 2) submission of a complete plan of action for the proposed youth workshops. The Small Community Grant Review Committee will

review the additional information and determine whether the contingency has been met.

7. Takoma Park Play Committee (\$500) – Traveling Play Groups.

BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute documents and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
