**Resolution 2010-24**

**Recognizing National Public Works Week, May 16-22, 2010**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Council thanks all Public Works Department employees for their dedicated service to the City; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Takoma Park residents and community organizations are encouraged to acquaint themselves with the services provided by our Public Works Department and recognize the contributions which public works employees make every day to the environment and to the health, safety, comfort, and quality of life in our City.
