**RESOLUTION #2010-61**

**ENDORING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROJECTS**

**WHEREAS,** the City anticipates receiving Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from Montgomery County during PY37 as a pass through from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

**WHEREAS,** the CDBG Advisory Committee, responsible for the initial review of requests for funding, found the Crossroads Farmers Market's Fresh Check Program and the City of Takoma Park's Facade Easement Program to further the community development goals of the City and to be eligible for CDBG funding; and

**WHEREAS,** the Council, having heard testimony on the needs of Takoma Park's low and moderate income residents during a public hearing held on September 27, 2010, and following a review of the proposed projects, concurred with the recommendations of the committee.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND** that the following CDBG eligible projects have been accepted for consideration for funding in PY37:

- 1) Crossroads Farmers Market Fresh Checks Program - Award \$25,000
- 2) City of Takoma Park Commercial Facade Easement Program - Award \$100,000

**BE IF FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit required applications for funding for the approved projects to Montgomery County Department of Housing and Community Affairs for further review.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute documents and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of these resolutions.
