RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY COALITION FOR THE HOMELESS'S APPLICATION FOR HUD SECTION 811 FUNDING

WHEREAS, Montgomery County Coalition for the Homeless, a nonprofit organization, works in partnership with the community to address the needs of those experiencing homelessness;

WHEREAS, Montgomery County Coalition for the Homeless provides permanent and transitional housing and support services to the homeless population, including very-low income persons with disabilities, so that they can live independently; and

WHEREAS, the organization purchased 8316 Flower Avenue, a six-unit rental property, in December 2009 and completed a substantial renovation in September 2010; and

WHEREAS, Montgomery County Coalition for the Homeless plans to fully occupy 8316 Flower Avenue by the end of 2010; and

WHEREAS, Montgomery County Coalition for the Homeless is applying to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funding under the HUD Section 811 program, which will assist in the completion and management of this project; and

WHEREAS, the City supports Montgomery County Coalition for the Homeless's application for HUD Section 811 program funds and the proposed project at 8316 Flower Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND hereby expresses approval of the project to be undertaken by Montgomery County Coalition for the Homeless and support of its application for funding through the HUD Section 811 Program, as described above.
