**RESOLUTION #2011-23**

**PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS  
TO THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Takoma Park Arts and Humanities Commission (AHC), established by Ordinance #2003-01, serves in an official advisory role to the City Council on all matters related to the arts and humanities; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides for the appointment of 15 members to the Commission, who serve staggered three-year terms; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Gehmelle Johnson, resident of Ward 4, and Ms. Janie Meneely, resident of Ward 6, have applied for appointment to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found Ms. Johnson and Ms. Meneely to be appropriate candidates for service on the Arts and Humanities Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND that Ms. Gehmelle L. Johnson and Ms. Janie Meneely are appointed, effective immediately, to serve on the Arts and Humanities Commission for three-year terms expiring June 30, 2014.
