Resolution 2011-24

Providing for an Appointment to the Emergency Preparedness Committee

WHEREAS, the City Council established the Emergency Preparedness Committee to provide community input and assistance in the City's planning and preparations for emergency operations; and

WHEREAS, as amended by Ordinance 2006-6, the committee is composed of appropriate senior City Staff selected by the City Manager, one member selected by the Takoma Park Volunteer Fire Department, one member selected by Washington Adventist Hospital, one member selected by the Montgomery County Department of Homeland Security, and seven residents appointed by the Council; and

WHEREAS, there are three resident vacancies on the committee; and

WHEREAS, Kay Daniels-Cohen has applied for appointment to the committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found Ms. Daniels-Cohen to be a qualified candidate for service on the committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT Kay Daniels-Cohen, resident of Ward 3, is hereby appointed, effective immediately, to serve on the Emergency Preparedness Committee with a term to expire on March 31, 2014.
