RESOLUTION 2011-37

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH MONTGOMERY COUNTY FOR DEBRIS MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Takoma Park desires to maintain the highest degree of cooperation with Montgomery County in providing effective emergency management; and

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Debris Management Plan includes provisions for the clearing, collection, removal and processing of debris resulting from a significant hazard or disaster occurring in Montgomery County; and

WHEREAS, Montgomery County's Debris Management Plan was approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency in December 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Debris Management Plan is part of the County's approved Emergency Operations Plan; and

WHEREAS, by entering into the Memorandum of Understanding with the County, the City of Takoma Park will be a party eligible to use the provisions of the Debris Management Plan upon activation of the Plan by Montgomery County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND authorizes the City Manager to sign a Memorandum of Understanding with Montgomery County regarding debris management.
