RESOLUTION #2011-39

**PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS
TO THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Takoma Park Arts and Humanities Commission (AHC), established by Ordinance #2003-01, serves in an official advisory role to the City Council on all matters related to the arts and humanities; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides for the appointment of 15 members to the Commission, one third of whom may be nonresidents, who serve staggered terms; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Sally Brucker, resident of Ward 1 and initially appointed to the AHC in February 2008, is seeking reappointment to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Joshua Prentice, a resident of Ward 2, and Ms. Ellen Chenoweth, a non-resident, have applied for appointment to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found Ms. Brucker, Mr. Prentice and Ms. Chenoweth to be appropriate candidates for service on the Arts and Humanities Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND that the following individuals are appointed, effective immediately, to serve on the Arts and Humanities Commission.
