RESOLUTION 2011-61
THANKING WARD 2 CITY COUNCILMEMBER COLLEEN CLAY
FOR HER SERVICE TO THE TAKOMA PARK COMMUNITY**

- WHEREAS, Colleen Clay was first elected to the City Council to represent Ward 2 on November 8, 2005 and took office on November 21, 2005; and,
- WHEREAS, Ms. Clay was reelected on November 6, 2007 and November 3, 2009; and,
- WHEREAS, during her three terms on the City Council, Colleen Clay was a vigorous advocate for residents of Ward 2; and,
- WHEREAS, in addition to her work on behalf of Ward 2 residents, Councilmember Clay made significant contributions to the City Council's deliberations of broad policy matters; and,
- WHEREAS, during her tenure on the City Council, Councilmember Clay showed a keen interest in planning and zoning matters, environmental sustainability, and recreation programming; and,
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Clay was a strong advocate for the rights of the disabled and the importance of accessibility in building a community; and,
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Clay was a proponent of tenants' rights, working diligently for enactment of a retaliatory eviction law; and,
- WHEREAS, Councilmember Clay did not seek reelection in the fall of 2011 and left office on November 21, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND hereby recognizes the contributions that Councilmember Colleen Clay made to the City of Takoma Park during her tenure on the Takoma Park City Council.
