WHEREAS, Dan Robinson was elected to the City Council to represent Ward 3 on November 6, 2007 and took office on November 19, 2007; and,

WHEREAS, Councilmember Robinson was reelected on November 3, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, during his tenure on the City Council, Mr. Robinson was a diligent advocate for Ward 3 residents; and,

WHEREAS, in addition to his work on behalf of Ward 3 residents, Councilmember Robinson made significant contributions to the City Council's deliberations of broad policy matters; and,

WHEREAS, during his tenure on the City Council, Councilmember Robinson showed a keen interest in environmental sustainability and small business development, willingly sharing his own experience as a business owner and developer; and,

WHEREAS, Councilmember Robinson championed issues related to the long-term financial viability of the City, including a fairer system of tax duplication payments and the impact of employee pension obligations; and,

WHEREAS, Councilmember Robinson was a strong voice for the value of municipal government; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Robinson did not seek reelection in the fall of 2011 and left office on November 21, 2011.
