Resolution 2012-23

Providing for an Appointment to the Recreation Committee

WHEREAS, the Recreation Committee was re-established as a statutory committee by Ordinance 2008-4 to advise the City Council on matters pertaining to recreation programs and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that the Committee shall consist of seven to 15 Takoma Park residents appointed by the Council, with every effort being made to ensure that the membership represents all wards and the diverse populations in Takoma Park; and

WHEREAS, members of the Committee are appointed to serve staggered two-year terms, beginning on May 1 and ending on April 30; and

WHEREAS, there are two vacancies on the Committee at this time; and

WHEREAS, Carolyn Leary Bobb, Ward 6 resident, has applied for appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that Ms. Bobb is an appropriate candidate for service on the Recreation Committee; and

WHEREAS, since Ms. Bobb will be appointed to a term that will expire on April 30, 2012, the Council desires to extend her term to include the next full term for the Committee, pursuant to *Takoma Park Code*, Chapter 2.16, Section 2.16.010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT Carolyn Leary Bobb, Ward 6, is appointed, effective immediately, to serve on the Recreation Committee to fill a vacant term that will expire on April 30, 2012; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT pursuant to *Takoma Park Code*, Chapter 2.16, Section 2.16.010, her term is extended to include the next full-term for the Committee, expiring April 30, 2014.
