RESOLUTION 2012-66

**PROVIDING FOR AN APPOINTMENT
TO THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Takoma Park Arts and Humanities Commission, established by Ordinance 2003-1, serves in an official advisory role to the City Council on all matters related to the arts and humanities; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2003-1 provides for the appointment of 15 members to the Commission, one-third of whom may be non-residents, who serve staggered terms; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Joshua Speiser, resident of Ward 5, has applied for appointment to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found Mr. Speiser to be an appropriate candidate for service on the Arts and Humanities Commission.
