RESOLUTION 2013-9

**PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS
TO THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Takoma Park Arts and Humanities Commission, established by Ordinance 2003-1, serves in an official advisory role to the City Council on all matters related to the arts and humanities; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2003-1 provides for the appointment of 15 members to the Commission, one-third of whom may be non-residents, who serve staggered terms; and

WHEREAS, Takoma Park residents Ms. Hannah Baldwin (Ward 3), Mr. Michael Desautels (Ward 3) and Ms. Michelle Ohnona (Ward 2) have applied for appointment to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found Ms. Baldwin, Mr. Desautels and Ms. Ohnona to be appropriate candidates for service on the Arts and Humanities Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND that the following individual is appointed, effective immediately, to serve on the Arts and Humanities Commission.
