**Resolution 2013-17**

**Providing for Reappointments to the Emergency Preparedness Committee**

WHEREAS, the City Council established the Emergency Preparedness Committee to provide community input and assistance in the City's planning and preparations for emergency operations; and

WHEREAS, as amended by Ordinance 2006-6, the Committee is composed of appropriate senior City Staff selected by the City Manager, one member selected by the Takoma Park Volunteer Fire Department, one member selected by Washington Adventist Hospital, one member selected by the Montgomery County Office of Emergency Management and Homeland Security, and seven residents appointed by the Council; and

WHEREAS, there are three vacancies on the Committee and two members' terms will expire on March 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Patrick Kimvilakani and Kathleen Quinn have applied for reappointment to the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found Mr. Kimvilakani and Ms. Quinn to be qualified candidates for continued service on the Emergency Preparedness Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT Patrick Kimvilakani (Ward 2) and Kathleen Quinn (Ward 2) are hereby reappointed to serve on the Emergency Preparedness Committee with terms to expire on March 31, 2016.
