RESOLUTION 2013-55

**AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH
TAKOMA LANGLEY CROSSROADS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS, the Takoma Park City Council's vision for Takoma Park, as set forth in its FY10-FY15 Strategic Plan, is for the advancement of a sustainable and livable community with an engaged, responsive and service-oriented government; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that to achieve this vision, it must work in partnership with city residents, community organizations, non-profits, the business community, and other governmental agencies; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate the creation of these desired partnerships, the Council established the Large Grant Program providing an annual funding opportunity for projects which further its vision for the community; and

WHEREAS, the Takoma Langley Crossroads Community Development Authority (CDA) applied for grant funds for its proposed gateway project, providing for the installation and maintenance of planters and landscaping materials for the beautification of the commercial area at the intersection of University Boulevard and New Hampshire Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Council has endorsed the CDA's grant application and included a total of \$4,615.00 in grant funds in its FY14 budget for the proposed project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND to approve an award of grant funds in the amount of four thousand six hundred fifteen dollars (\$4,615.00) to the Takoma Langley Crossroads Community Development Authority for its FY14 gateway beautification project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any agreements and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
