**RESOLUTION 2013-66
PROVIDING FOR AN APPOINTMENT TO THE VOTING TASK FORCE**

WHEREAS, the City Council established a Voting Task Force to make recommendations on any policies or regulations needed to strengthen the right to vote and voter participation in City elections; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force is to consist of up to 11 members who are Takoma Park residents or who represent organizations with expertise in election laws or policy, voting rights or voter registration; and

WHEREAS, at least two members of the Task Force are to be members of the Board of Elections; and

WHEREAS, the Council shall aim to appoint at least two youth members aged 16 to 21 on the date of appointment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council appointed six members to the Task Force on July 8, 2013 and 2 members on September 23, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Leandra Carrasco, Ward 3 resident, has applied to serve; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found Ms. Carrasco to be an appropriate candidate for appointment to the Task Force.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK THAT the following individual is hereby appointed to serve on the Voting Task Force:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Ms. Carrasco's term shall expire on June 30, 2014 unless the term of the Task Force is extended by the Council.
