RESOLUTION 2014-4

**AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH
MAKING A NEW UNITED PEOPLE (M.A.N.U.P.)**

WHEREAS, the Takoma Park City Council's vision for Takoma Park, as set forth in its FY10-FY15 Strategic Plan, is for the advancement of a sustainable and livable community with an engaged, responsive and service-oriented government; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that to achieve this vision, it must work in partnership with city residents, community organizations, non-profits, the business community, and other governmental agencies; and

WHEREAS, Making A New United People (M.A.N.U.P.) requested grant funds for a proposed *College Bound Program*, a new service preparing Takoma Park's teens for their transition to higher education; and

WHEREAS, the Council has endorsed M.A.N.U.P.'s request and included \$15,000 in grant funds in its FY14 budget for the proposed project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND to approve an award of grant funds in the amount of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) to Making A New United People (M.A.N.U.P.) for its FY14 *College Bound* program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any agreements and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
