**CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND**

**RESOLUTION 2014-15  
AUTHORIZING A WAIVER OF THE AUDITORIUM RENTAL FEE AND  
ASSOCIATED STAFFING FEE FOR SCREENING OF THE MOVIE *LUNCH HOUR***

WHEREAS, Real Food for Kids – Montgomery (RFFK) is a grassroots, parent advocacy group promoting healthy foods in Montgomery County Public Schools; and

WHEREAS, the organization reserved the Auditorium for screening of the movie *Lunch Hour*, which addresses school lunch policy and implementation; and

WHEREAS, the cost to use the Auditorium at the nonprofit rate would be \$330 and the staffing cost for use of facilities after hours would be \$120; and

WHEREAS, RFFK applied for a small grant from the City to fund, among other things, the cost of the event; and

WHEREAS, because the small grant awards will not be made until after the movie screening, the group has requested a fee waiver; and

WHEREAS, the Council has endorsed this waiver.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT the City Manager is hereby authorized to waive the rental and staffing cost of \$450 for use of the Takoma Park Auditorium for screening of the movie *Lunch Hour* on May 3, 2014.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT in the event Real Food for Kids – Montgomery receives a small grant from the City, this rental and staffing cost of \$450 shall be deducted from the amount of the grant.
