RESOLUTION 2014 -17

**PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS
TO THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Takoma Park Arts and Humanities Commission, established by Ordinance 2003-1, serves in an official advisory role to the City Council on all matters related to the arts and humanities; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2003-1 provides for the appointment of 15 members to the Commission, one-third of whom may be non-residents; and

WHEREAS, members are appointed to staggered three-year terms; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Gelynn Hurt (Ward 3), Ms. Elizabeth Mische (Ward 5), Ms. Susan Strasser (Ward 1), and Ms. Iva Saller (Non Resident) have applied for appointment to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found each of the applicants to be an appropriate candidate for appointment to the Arts and Humanities Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND that the following individuals are appointed, effective immediately, to serve on the Arts and Humanities Commission:
