**RESOLUTION 2014-18
APPOINTING A MEMBER TO THE COMMITTEE ON THE ENVIRONMENT**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 2012-37, the City Council redefined and reestablished the Committee on the Environment to serve as an important partner and advisor in matters related to environmental sustainability, protection, and restoration; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is to be composed of 11-15 members appointed to staggered two-year terms; and

WHEREAS, there are currently two vacancies on the Committee; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kirby Rootes-Murdy (Ward 4) has applied to serve; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed Mr. Rootes-Murdy's application and found him to be a qualified candidate for service on the Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK THAT Mr. Kirby Rootes-Murdy (Ward 4) is hereby appointed to serve on the Committee on the Environment for a term to expire on June 30, 2016.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this appointment shall become effective immediately.
