**RESOLUTION 2014-35  
PROVIDING FOR A REAPPOINTMENT  
TO THE COMMITTEE ON THE ENVIRONMENT**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 2012-37, the City Council redefined and reestablished the Committee on the Environment to serve as an important partner and advisor in matters related to environmental sustainability, protection, and restoration; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is to be composed of 11-15 members appointed to staggered two-year terms; and

WHEREAS, there are currently two vacancies on the Committee and one member whose term expired on June 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Allyson's Piazza has applied for reappointment to the Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has evaluated her application and desires to reappoint her.
