RESOLUTION 2015-10

PROVIDING FOR AN APPOINTMENT TO THE SAFE ROADWAYS COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to the goal of creating a sustainable, pedestrian-friendly and walkable community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to work in partnership with the community and City staff to achieve this goal; and

WHEREAS, the Safe Roadways Committee was re-established by Ordinance 2012-38 to serve in an official advisory and coordination role to the City Council on all matters related to transportation, including, but not limited to, pedestrian and bicycle facilities and safety, traffic issues, and transit services; and

WHEREAS, up to 11 residents may be appointed to the Committee; and

WHEREAS, members serve staggered two-year terms that expire on June 30 but may serve no more than six years continuously; and

WHEREAS, at the present time there are three vacancies on the Committee; and

WHEREAS, Nicholas Finio, resident of Ward 3, has applied for appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed his application and desires to appoint Mr. Finio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT Nicholas Finio (Ward 3) is hereby appointed to the Safe Roadways Committee for a term to expire on June 30, 2016.
