NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT Frank Demarais, Ward 5 resident, and Michael Moore, Ward 6 resident, are hereby appointed to the Safe Roadways Committee to terms that expire on June 30,
