**RESOLUTION 2016-8
PROVIDING FOR REAPPOINTMENTS
TO THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the City Council established the Emergency Preparedness Committee to provide community input and assistance in the City's planning and preparations for emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is composed of appropriate senior City Staff selected by the City Manager, one member selected by the Takoma Park Volunteer Fire Department, one member selected by Washington Adventist Hospital, one member selected by the Montgomery County Office of Emergency Management and Homeland Security, seven residents appointed by the Council, and up to five additional representative members appointed by Council resolution; and

WHEREAS, there are three resident members whose terms will expire on March 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Kathleen Quinn and Claudine Schweber have applied for reappointment; and

WHEREAS, the Council has found both to be appropriate candidates for service on the Committee.
