**RESOLUTION 2017-2**

**PROVIDING FOR AN APPOINTMENT TO THE TAKOMA JUNCTION COMMUNITY  
PROCESS ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS,** the City Council created the Takoma Junction Community Process Advisory Committee, Resolution 2016-27, to facilitate community input on the Takoma Junction redevelopment project; and

**WHEREAS,** City Council recognizes the value of appointing a committee of residents to provide guidance in appropriate ways to engage the community in the development of the project; and

**WHEREAS,** the Takoma Junction Community Process Advisory Committee consists of seven members, with at least one member from each ward; and

**WHEREAS,** Ms. Janet Williams, a resident of Ward 4 and an experienced coordinator of local groups and volunteers, has submitted an application to fill a vacancy; and

**WHEREAS,** the Council has found this individual to be an appropriate candidate to serve on the Takoma Junction Community Process Advisory Committee.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT** Ms. Janet Williams is appointed effective January 11, 2017 to serve on the Takoma Junction Community Process Advisory Committee.
