**PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT
TO THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Arts and Humanities Commission, established by Ordinance 2003-1, serves in an official advisory role to the City Council on all matters related to the arts and humanities; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2003-1 provides for the appointment of 15 members to the Commission, one-third of whom may be non-residents; and

WHEREAS, members are appointed to staggered three-year terms; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Marilyn Sklar, resident of Ward 3, has applied for appointment to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found Ms. Sklar to be an appropriate candidate for appointment to the Arts and Humanities Commission.
