**RESOLUTION 2018-25**

**AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR DESIGN PROJECT FUNDING THROUGH  
THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Alternatives Program, funded under MAP-21, the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act, provides for a variety of alternative transportation projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Takoma Park is submitting an application for funding for the redesign of the Takoma Junction intersection in the amount of \$800,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Alternatives Program requires applicants provide a minimum 20% cash match for eligible construction activities for projects submitted for funding consideration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Alternatives Program deadline for applications is May 16, 2018, and project awards are anticipated to be announced in September 2018.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Takoma Park authorizes the Transportation Alternatives Program application, for the Redesign of the Takoma Junction Intersection in the amount of \$800,000;

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Takoma Park commits to assuring the 20% cash match requirement for eligible design activities for the project submitted for Transportation Alternatives funding consideration.
