**RESOLUTION 2018-30
PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS
TO THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the City Council established the Emergency Preparedness Committee to provide community input and assistance in the City's planning and preparations for emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is composed of appropriate senior City Staff selected by the City Manager, one member selected by the Takoma Park Volunteer Fire Department, one member selected by the Montgomery County Office of Emergency Management and Homeland Security, seven residents appointed by the Council, and up to five additional representative members appointed by Council resolution; and

WHEREAS, Andy Keleman has applied for reappointment to serve on the committee; and

WHEREAS, Josue Canas has applied for appointment to serve as a representative member on the committee; and

WHEREAS, the Council has found the applicants to be a qualified candidates to serve on the Emergency Preparedness Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT Andy Keleman, Ward 1 resident, is appointed to serve on the Emergency Preparedness Committee for a term to expire in 2021 and Josue Canas, Department of Health and Human Services is appointed to serve as a representative member.
