**RESOLUTION 2018-60**

**PROVIDING FOR AN APPOINTMENT TO THE SAFE ROADWAYS COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to the goal of creating a sustainable, pedestrian-friendly and walkable community; and

WHEREAS, the Safe Roadways Committee was re-established by Ordinance 2012-38 to serve in an official advisory and coordination role to the City Council on all matters related to transportation, including, but not limited to, pedestrian and bicycle facilities and safety, traffic issues, and transit services; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is to be composed of up to 11 residents appointed to staggered two-year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Safe Roadways Committee has been inactive for the past year due to changes in leadership and declining membership; and

WHEREAS, the remaining members have expressed a willingness to work with the Council to consider how best to structure the Committee to make it sustainable and able to fulfill its advisory role; and

WHEREAS, Jessica Landman, Ward 1 resident, has applied to serve on the Committee and has indicated her interest in participating in discussions about reorganizing it.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT Jessica Landman, a resident of Ward 1, is hereby appointed to the Safe Roadways Committee for a term to expire June 30, 2020.
