**RESOLUTION 2019-32**

**PROVIDING FOR REAPPOINTMENTS  
TO THE ARTS AND HUMANITIES COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Arts and Humanities Commission, established by Ordinance 2003-1, serves in an official advisory role to the City Council on all matters related to the arts and humanities; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2003-1 provides for the appointment of 15 members to the Commission, one-third of whom may be non-residents; and

WHEREAS, members are appointed to staggered three-year terms; and

WHEREAS, Ebonee Harlee (non-resident), Joelle Rabion (non-resident), and Courtney Tompkins (Ward 2) have applied for re-appointment to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found the applicants for reappointment to be qualified candidates for continued service on the Arts and Humanities Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND that the following individuals are reappointed, effective July 1, 2019, to serve on the Arts and Humanities Commission:
