RESOLUTION 2019-33

**PROVIDING FOR REAPPOINTMENTS
TO THE COMMITTEE ON THE ENVIRONMENT**

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 2012-37, the City Council redefined and reestablished the Committee on the Environment to serve as an important partner and advisor in matters related to environmental sustainability, protection, and restoration; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is to be composed of 11-15 members appointed to staggered two-year terms; and

WHEREAS, there are currently four vacancies on the Committee and three members whose terms expired on June 30; and

WHEREAS, John Ackerly (Ward 2) and Kirsten Stade (Ward 4) have applied for reappointment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds them to be qualified candidates for continued service on the Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAKOMA PARK, MARYLAND THAT John Ackerly and Kirsten Stade are hereby reappointed to serve on the Committee on the Environment for terms that will expire on June 30, 2021.
