RESOLUTION 2022-21

**PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS AND REAPPOINTMENTS TO THE
ARTS AND HUMANITIES COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the Arts and Humanities Committee is established in Chapter 2.16, Article 2 of the Takoma Park Code and its duties and responsibilities are listed therein; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is composed of up to nine members appointed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Arts and Humanities Committee members are appointed to two-year terms, however, beginning in 2021, the initial terms for half of the Committee's members were scheduled to end on June 30, 2022, and half of the members' terms will expire on June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, after the initial terms expire, all terms of office for members appointed or reappointed will be staggered two-year terms beginning on July 1 and ending on June 30; and

WHEREAS, a subgroup of three City Councilmembers reviewed applications and made recommendations for appointments at the work session on July 13 to the full Council; and

WHEREAS, Jose Luis Diaz (Ward 2), Taylor Johnson (non-resident), and Linette Lander (Ward 6) have applied for appointment; and

WHEREAS, Leslie Sapp (Ward 3) and John Warren (Ward 5) have applied for reappointment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the following individuals are hereby appointed or reappointed to the Arts and Humanities Committee with terms to expire as indicated:
