**RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NATIONAL SETTLEMENT AGREEMENTS
WITH JASSEN AND THE DISTRIBUTORS IN THE OPIOID LITIGATION AND
MARYLAND SUBDIVISION AGREEMENTS**

WHEREAS, national litigation regarding the impact of the distribution and use of Opioids has resulted in proposed settlement agreements with Jassen and the Distributors (Johnson & Johnson, Amerisource Bergen, Cardinal Health and McKesson (“National Settlements”)); and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Attorney General has proposed a State-Subdivision Agreement to implement the distribution of funds to local governments in Maryland received through the National Settlements; and

WHEREAS, under the National Settlements and State-Subdivision Agreement the City will receive funds and be eligible for grants to combat Opioid use within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that entry into the National Settlements and State-Subdivision Agreement is in the best interests of the City and its residents.


