## **RESOLUTION 2023-10**

## PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENTS TO THE NUCLEAR-FREE TAKOMA PARK COMMITTEE

- WHEREAS, the Takoma Park Nuclear-Free Committee is established in Chapter 2.16, Article 8 of the Takoma Park Code and its responsibilities are listed therein; and
- WHEREAS, the committee is composed of up to nine members appointed by the City Council; and
- WHERAS, Nuclear-Free Takoma Park Committee members are appointed to staggered twoyear terms, however, these mid-term appointments are to fill vacancies with terms to expire on June 30, 2023; and
- WHEREAS, at the expiration of the short-term appointments, the appointees are eligible to apply for full terms; and
- WHEREAS, a subcommittee of three City Councilmembers reviewed applications and made recommendations to the full council at the work session on February 22; and
- WHEREAS, Adam Frank and William Allen-DePraw were recommended for appointment to the Nuclear-Free Takoma Park Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Adam Frank (Ward 2) and William Allen-DuPraw (Ward 1) are appointed to the Nuclear-Free Takoma Park Committee with terms to expire on June 30, 2023; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Nuclear-Free Takoma Park Committee membership is subject to provisions of Chapter 2.16 of the Takoma Park Code; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
