RESOLUTION 2023-3

**PROVIDING FOR AN APPOINTMENT TO THE
ARTS AND HUMANITIES COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the Arts and Humanities Committee is established in Chapter 2.16, Article 2 of the Takoma Park Code and its duties and responsibilities are listed therein; and

WHEREAS, the Committee is composed of up to nine members appointed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Arts and Humanities Committee members are appointed to staggered two-year terms, however, this mid-term appointment is to fill a vacancy with a term that expires on June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, at the expiration of the short-term appointment, the appointee is eligible to apply for a full term; and

WHEREAS, a subcommittee of three City Councilmembers reviewed applications and made recommendations to the full Council at the work session on February 15; and

WHEREAS, Rick Henry was recommended for appointment to the Arts and Humanities Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Rick Henry, Ward 3, is appointed to the Arts and Humanities Committee with a term to expire on June 30, 2023; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Arts and Humanities Committee membership is subject to provisions of Chapter 2.16 of the Takoma Park Code; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
