PROVIDING FOR AN APPOINTMENT TO THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS COMMITTEE

- WHEREAS, the Emergency Preparedness Committee is established in Chapter 2.16, Article 4 of the Takoma Park Code and its duties and responsibilities are listed therein; and
- WHEREAS, the Committee is composed of up to nine members appointed by the City Council; and
- WHEREAS, Emergency Preparedness Committee members are appointed to staggered two-year terms, however, this mid-term appointment is to fill a vacancy with a term that expires on June 30, 2023; and
- WHEREAS, at the expiration of the short-term appointment, the appointee is eligible to apply for a full term; and
- WHEREAS, a subcommittee of three City Councilmembers reviewed applications and made recommendations to the full Council at the work session on February 15; and
- WHEREAS, Frank Disimino was recommended for appointment to the Emergency Preparedness Committee; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Frank Disimino, Ward 4, is appointed to the Emergency Preparedness Committee with a term that expires on June 30, 2023; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Emergency Preparedness Committee membership is subject to provisions of Chapter 2.16 of the Takoma Park Code; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
