PROVIDING FOR AN APPOINTMENT TO THE TAKOMA PARK ETHICS COMMISSION

- WHEREAS, the Ethics Commission is established in Chapter 3.04, Section 3.04.050 et seq. of the Takoma Park Code and its responsibilities are listed therein; and
- WHEREAS, the Ethics Commission is composed of up to seven members appointed by the City Council; and
- WHEREAS, Ethics Commission members are appointed to staggered three-year terms, however, this mid-term appointment is to fill a vacancy with a term to expire on June 30, 2025; and
- WHEREAS, after the initial term has expired, the appointee is eligible to apply for a full term; and
- WHEREAS, a subcommittee of three City Councilmembers reviewed applications and made recommendations to the full Council on February 15; and
- WHEREAS, Mark Samburg was recommended for appointment to the Ethics Commission; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT that Mark Samburg, Ward 1, is appointed to the Ethics Commission for a term to expire on June 30, 2025; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Ethics Commission membership is subject to provisions of Chapter 2.17 of the Takoma Park Code; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
