## SUPPORT FOR FY24 STATE REVITALIZATION PROGRAM NATIONAL CAPITAL STRATEGIC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND (NED) GRANT AWARDS FOR MULTIFAMILY BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS

- **WHEREAS**, the Takoma Park City Council recognizes the need to ensure that a range of safe, high-quality, affordable, green, and energy-efficient housing options are equitably available in neighborhoods throughout the community; and
- WHEREAS, the City applied for and was awarded a State Revitalization grant in the amount of \$250,000 to assist small scale (5 25 unit) rent-stabilized multifamily properties complete weatherization, energy efficiency, and electrification improvements to preserve affordable housing, reduce utility costs, and address climate change; and
- WHEREAS, the project will contribute to the Council's priority of an environmentally sustainable community.
