COVID-19 Related Information

COVID-19 Dashboard

Each week, the City continues to update the COVID-19 Dashboard found here: COVID 19 Dashboard. There were no new cases of COVID-19 reported in Takoma Park in the last week, leaving the city's total at 1,728 since the start of the pandemic. In all of June 2021, 3 total new cases of COVID-19 were reported in Takoma Park. Even if some June cases are reported later, June will likely have the fewest new cases of any month since the start of the pandemic, followed by the 17 cases reported in March 2020. Between July 1 and July 8, 161 new residents received at-least a first-dose of a vaccination and 179 new residents became fully-vaccinated, bringing the city's total residents with at least a first dose to 14,225 (80.5% of all residents) and the total fully vaccinated residents to 12,452 (70.5%).

Thanks to this continued good news, the City continues to progress on a phased reopening timeline. Currently, Public Works, the Police Department, and the Library are open to the public, and passport and notary services are available in the Community Center on an appointment only basis. Masks are required in public areas of City facilities. A full reopening of all City facilities including the Community Center and Recreation Center is planned for August 23rd.

Vaccinations Available!

Unvaccinated residents are encouraged to get vaccinated. Current vaccines have been shown to be effective at both preventing people from getting the more-contagious Delta variant and reducing the severity of symptoms from the Delta variant. Please get vaccinated if you haven't been already – it really helps us all return to normal.
