# Housing & Community Development Updates:

- May 18th from 6:30 pm to 8:00 pm at the Langley Park Community Center is the New Hampshire Ave Flash Bus Rapid Transit- Community Advisory Committee meeting. ### • <u>Council Requests/Updates</u>

**WAU Property Tax Exempt Status**: Staff is working with the State Department of Assessment and Taxation to remove the tax exemptions for the site of the former Washington Adventist Hospital, beginning July 1, 2023. If the property owners cannot provide a satisfactory description of charitable activity at the site, then the exemptions will be removed. However, the property owners will be able to appeal that decision to the Property Tax Assessment Appeals Board.
