## **Public Works:**

- For the week of December 4<sup>th</sup>, the City's street resurfacing contractor will be milling and paving Linden Avenue and the New Hampshire Ave service lane around the former Hillwood Manor Apartment complex, now the Colonnade at the Creek. Montgomery Housing Partnership and the City are collaborating on the project, which will include paving the City owned portion of the roadway as well as the privately-owned portion of the service road and parking spaces. MHP has agreed to reimburse the City for the cost of paving on private property.
- Reminder- Leaf collection is continuing through December 15. Residents can rake leaves to the curb at their convenience. The City is divided into 5 zones for collection and each zone has a leaf vacuum assigned. City crews pick up leaf piles street by street throughout their zone. Every street will receive at least 2 collections and usually receive 3 or more. The State roads, which include Philadelphia Ave, Piney Branch Rd, Ethan Allen Ave and Carroll Ave, plus Flower Ave between Carroll Ave and University Blvd have two scheduled pick-up dates. These streets are collected differently due to the traffic volumes and need to reduce traffic impacts from collection. Residents can also report their leaf piles by calling the leaf collection hotline 301 891 7626.
