- Updates on the Takoma Park Minor Master Plan process can be found on the City website. Currently, the Montgomery County Council Committee on Planning, Housing, and Parks is holding work sessions. The second work session was held on February 5th, and the Committee made the following decisions:
 - o Remove the language asking the City to consider changes to the rent stabilization policy
 - Raise the Moderately-Priced Dwelling Unit (MPDU) requirement to 15%, from the previous 12.5%
 - o Amend the language about "no net loss of existing affordable housing" to be district-wide
 - O Planning staff will review the height limits for the Municipal District for parcels 8,9, 10, 11, 12, and 19, for further discussion at the next worksession.
- HCD and PW staff continue to welcome feedback from City Council on the proposed Administrative Regulations to Traffic Calming and Sidewalk Requests presented to Council on Wednesday, January 17th. Pending Council feedback, Staff hopes to release draft Regulations for Public Comment in March 2024.

- The Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) is reviewing the impact of recent changes made to the intersection of Carroll Avenue and Philadelphia Avenue as a result of their Carroll Avenue street restoration project. The City's Construction Manager has been in contact with MDOT as they develop their plans. The current plan proposed will adjust the travel lanes on Carroll Avenue to accommodate a wider lane for bus turns from Carroll Ave to Philadelphia Ave, and the reduction of the two lanes on Carroll at the firehouse to one lane, for a short distance, before resuming the existing two lanes traveling northwest.
