HCD Department:

- The City has received over 100 submissions from our tenant survey released last month. The survey was mailed to every tenant in the city and closes on May 1st. The City also has a Landlord Survey that was distributed to landlords and will close on May 1st as well.
- The City will be submitting a grant application for the US Department of Transportation's Safe Streets and Roads for All program, by April 4th. The grant is a part of the federal Bipartisan Infrastructure Law and will allow the City to develop an Action Plan and Demonstration Project. The goal of an Action Plan is to develop a holistic, well-defined strategy to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries. This item will be coming up on the agenda later this evening with a Resolution asking the Mayor and Council to submission of this grant.
- Red Hound Pizza is a new restaurant that will be opening in 7050 Carroll Avenue in the Spring 2024. Red Hound is the first recipient of the City's new "Open for Business" grant.

Library:

- April is National Poetry month come check out some poetry from our stacks and consider attending some of our poetry programs this month.
- April is also Arab American heritage month, and we have a book display up with books for all ages by Arab American authors.
