

# Notice of Campaign Activity

City of Takoma Park law requires multi-unit residential property managers to allow candidates to enter residential buildings to reach residents. Registered political candidates have the right to enter multi-unit buildings for the 90 day period before a primary, general, or special election, for the purposes of going door-to-door to distribute campaign material and to speak with residents. Candidates must provide 24 hours' notice to residents prior to entering a multi-unit residential building.
