

- Size: 5.96 acres totalZoning: R-60/RT12.5Access: Ellsworth Drive
- Topography: The site is relatively flat with a raised area and small hill.
- Current Use: County tenant and Ellsworth Park
- Comments: The former library site combined with the neighboring local park would provide adequate area for an elementary school. Traffic on Colesville Road can be heavy in the morning and evening rush hours. Improvements would be needed on Ellsworth Drive to accommodate bus and drop off traffic.

- Location: 9701 Sligo Creek Parkway, Silver Spring
- Size: 88.91 acresZoning: R-60
- Access: Sligo Creek Parkway
- Topography: The site is hilly with open flat areas.
- Current Use: Sligo Creek Golf Course
- Comments: The golf course could accommodate a middle school in addition to an elementary school. There are storm water management ponds and forested areas that would have to be avoided. The site could also accommodate other county uses such as parkland and play areas.
