
Submitted Ward Map – Option 1 – 9.2% deviation



Submission comment: "I just transferred over the map I created on davesredistricting.org (DRA) when the census information first came out. I created what seemed to be the closest to even population map that I could get that eliminated the hourglass shape of Ward 3 and therefore made all the wards more compact. In fact about as compact as is possible while maintaining even populations at the census block level. I would shift individual addresses if I could to make them even more compact and closer in population; however, the tools do not allow that level of specificity even though the old wards did appear to be more precisely drawn than even at the census block level. 


Submitted Ward Map – Option 3 – 1.8% deviation


