RECYCLING NOTICE



City of Takoma Park law requires all residents and business to separate recycling from trash. Failure to separate the recycling for your unit may result in a municipal fine. For tenants, failure to separate trash and recycling constitutes a breach of your lease, which is grounds for termination of your tenancy.

For condominium owners, failure to separate trash and recycling constitutes a violation of the condominium association's rules, which may subject you to penalties in accordance with your association's bylaws.

Paper & Cardboard

boxboard • cardboard boxes • catalogs • corrugated cardboard • envelopes •
junk mail • magazines • newspapers • paper bags • paperboard
paperback books • phone books • white & colored paper • wrapping paper

Place all paper in a paper bag or tie into a bundle and place in recycling bin.

Cardboard boxes must be broken down.

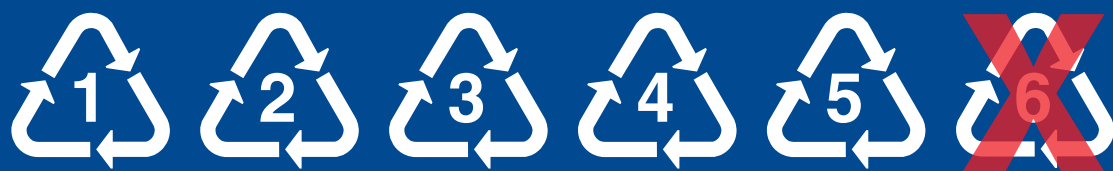
Paper must be dry and not soiled with food or other materials. Throw soiled or wet paper & cardboard in the trash.

Glass, Metal & Plastic

aerosol cans (empty) • aluminum foil & trays • cans • glass bottles & jars
metal food & beverage containers • plastic bottles, buckets, jars, pots & tubs
plastic containers marked with #1 through #5 recycling symbols



Plastic Recycling Symbols



Plastic containers marked with the #1 through #5 symbol can be recycled.
Items marked with the #6 symbol are polystyrene and cannot be recycled.
