Paper & Cardboard

boxboard • cardboard boxes • catalogs • corrugated cardboard • envelopes • junk mail • magazines • newspapers
paper bags • paperboard • paperback books • phone books • white & colored paper • wrapping paper

Place all paper in a paper bag or tie into a bundle and place in recycling bin. Cardboard boxes must be broken down.
Paper must be dry and not soiled with food or other materials. Throw soiled or wet paper & cardboard in the trash.

Glass, Metal & Plastic

aerosol cans (empty) • aluminum foil & trays • cans • glass bottles & jars • metal food & beverage containers
plastic bottles, buckets, jars, pots & tubs • plastic containers marked with #1 through #5 recycling symbols

Plastic containers marked with the #1 through #5 symbol can be recycled.
Items marked with the #6 symbol are polystyrene and cannot be recycled.
